New Airport Fees and Policies

On December 10, 2024 The El Dorado County Board of Supervisors approved revisions to fees and Airport Policies. Go to eldorado.legistar.com to review reports, changes, and new documents.

New fees go into effect January 9, 2025, and we will begin processing leases after that date.

Inspections

Annual FAA hangar Inspections have taken place and will be doing make-up inspections in the next month for those who were unavailable. If you have not already had your hangar inspected or arranged an inspection date with us, please contact us. Thank you to all who have participated.

Vegetation Management

Current and future obstructions are being cleared at both airports. Burn season is upon us. If there is any brush you need to remove from around your hangar, you can bring it to the east end at the Placerville airport, and for Georgetown, you can bring it to the end of the taxiway near the fence for staff to take care of.

REMINDERS

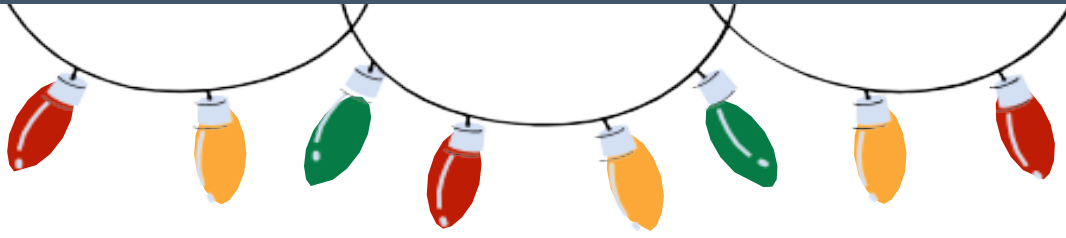
Please avoid parking in areas where you will track mud back out on the ramp. The mud at both airports usually contains a good amount of rocks which can be detrimental to aircraft propellers.

The cold is coming and it's time to start getting the airport ready. If you have a hose bib at your hangar, please ensure it is wrapped in foam insulation to protect it from freezing.

Please advise airport staff if you need assistance winterizing around your hangar or if you notice any others that need to be taken care of.
