WHAT DO I NEED TO SUBMIT WITH MY LICENSE APPLICATION?

- RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE: Submit a copy of a valid rabies vaccination certificate that is issued and signed by a licensed veterinarian.
 - Please note: A license can be obtained for either one or three years but cannot exceed the expiration date of the rabies vaccination. A license cannot be purchased if a rabies vaccination is due to expire in less than 3 months. If your dog's rabies vaccination is due to expire in less than 3 months, you will need to have your dog revaccinated prior to obtaining a license. Do not send a metal rabies tag issued by your veterinarian, as it is not proof of a rabies vaccination. Your dog license will expire when the current rabies vaccination expires.
- A License will not be considered valid if a valid rabies certificate is not on file.
- IF YOUR DOG IS SPAYED OR NEUTERED: In order to obtain a discounted license rate, submit a copy of the spay or neuter certificate issued by your veterinarian. The certificate should state a complete description of the dog and the date of the surgery. Once the certificate is submitted, dog licensing does not require proof each time the license is renewed.
