		B Work is to include, at a minimum:
		Sawcut, remove and dispose of Portland cement concrete curb, sidewalk, stairs and asphalt concrete paving as shown in the Contract Documents.
		 Protect landscape, irrigation and electrical lines, and appurtenances as shown in the Contract Documents.
		 Install temporary ADA parking stalls, signs and stair ramp as shown in the Contract Documents.
		Install new and modify existing drainage improvements as shown in the Contract Documents.
		 Install new Portland cement concrete curb, gutter, sidewalk, stairs and asphalt concrete paving as shown in the Contract Documents.
		 Repair failed trench as shown in the Contract Documents.
		 Install final striping, signage and wheel stops as shown in the Contract Documents.
		 All items to be removed and replaced such as stairs and sidewalk shall be removed and replaced in kind; matching the surfacing and details including stair bull noses and exposed aggregate surfacing.

		5-1.08 PUBLIC SAFETY
		The Contractor shall provide, place and maintain all lights, signs, delineators, temporary striping or other devices necessary to provide for the safe and convenient passage of public vehicle and pedestrian traffic through the construction site.
		All temporary construction fencing shall be installed prior to any demolition work commencing.
		The drive aisle within the fenced construction area shall remain free of construction materials. In case of an emergency, the temporary construction fencing blocking the drive aisle shall be easily removed to allow for vehicular traffic.
		Replace section 6-1.09 with the following:
		6-1.09 TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION FENCE
		Temporary construction fence shall be furnished, constructed, maintained and later removed as shown on the plans and as directed by the Engineer. Used materials may be installed, provided the used materials are good, sound and are suitable for the purpose intended. Materials shall be commercial quality provided the dimensions and sizes are equal to or greater than the dimensions and sizes shown on the plans or specified herein.
		Fencing: Chain link fence panels, minimum 36" height. The fence is to be free standing and without the need to set posts in ground. Panels are to be held upright by standard "T" footings or concrete block.
		The chain link fence panels are to be placed continuously end to end around entire perimeter of project site as shown on plans or directed by the Engineer.
		Full compensation for conforming to the requirements of this section shall be considered as included in the Lump Sum Price bid for the contract and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.
