The Board convened in regular meeting. Present: Supervisors John M. Caswell, Eugene A. Chappie, R. G. Chism, John D'Agostini and Jack M. Wallace; also Barbara L. Cook, Clerk to the Board. Chairman D'Agostini presiding.

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On motion of Supervisor Chism, seconded by Supervisor Caswell, and unanimously carried, the Agenda is hereby adopted.

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On motion of Supervisor Chism, seconded by Supervisor Caswell, and unanimously carried, the minutes of July 1, 1963, are approved as submitted.

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PLANNING MATTERS
