BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES July 9, 1964

The Board convened in adjourned meeting. Present: Supervisors John M. Caswell, Eugene A. Chappie, John D'Agostini, and Jack M. Wallace; also Barbara L. Cook, Clerk to the Board. Absent: Supervisor R. G. Chism. Chairman Caswell presiding.

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Others present: Mr. Bruce Austin of the State Personnel Board, County Clerk Ruth Lang, Assessor Thomas J. Sigwart, Treasurer Albert Frey, Tax Collector C. A. Steves, Recorder James Sweeney, and Auditor Amelia McAnnally.

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The Board discussed various personnel matters.

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On motion of Supervisor Chappie, seconded by Supervisor Wallace, and carried, the following Ordinance is passed and adopted:

ORDINANCE NO. 649

AMENDING EL DORADO COUNTY SALARY ORDINANCE

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LHR 318- On motion of Supervisor Chappie, seconded by Supervisor D'Agostini, and carried, Ronald A. Brazill is appointed County Engineer, Step A, Extra Help, from July 1 to July 31, 1964.

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LHR 22-3 On motion of Supervisor Chappie, seconded by Supervisor D'Agostini, and carried, Larry B. Reiger is appointed Laborer, Step B, Extra Help, from July 1 to July 31, 1964.

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At this point, Supervisor Wallace departed.

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LHR 344 On motion of Supervisor D'Agostini, seconded by Supervisor Chappie, and carried, the Chairman is authorized to send a letter to Pacific Gas & Electric Co. requesting they install and replace a total of 19 new lights

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LHR 344 on Highway 49 through Diamond Springs and the extremity of Fowler Lane in Diamond Heights at a cost of \$516.20; funds to come from Diamond Springs Lighting District budget.

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Supervisor Wallace returned.

LHR 250 On motion of Supervisor Chappie, seconded by Supervisor Wallace, and carried, Farl Grundy, Fire Chief of the City of Placerville, is hereby authorized to burn weeds around the County Hospital at a cost of \$50.00.

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No further business, the Board adjourned to reconvene on Monday, July 13, 1964, at 9:30 A.M.
