On motion of Supervisor Lawyer, seconded by Supervisor Martin, and unanimously carried, petitions with 877 signatures requesting the Board to refuse any further antlerless deer hunts until the deer population shows a need therefor were placed on file.

On motion of Supervisor Lawyer, seconded by Supervisor Ronzone, and carried by the following vote: Ayes: Supervisors Ronzone, Lawyer, Worrell and Walker; No: Supervisor Martin; the following resolution was adopted:


