The purpose of this special meeting, adjourned from July 1, 1976, was to consider adoption of an urgency ordinance prohibiting outdoor open burning within the unincorporated area of El Dorado County due to dangerous fire conditions and lack of moisture. Meeting was continued from July 1, 1976 of necessity, as four Board members needed to be present for adoption of an urgency ordinance.

After discussion was held, on motion of Supervisor Kutter, seconded by Supervisor Walker, and unanimously carried by those present, the Board of Supervisors, having found the need to restrict outdoor open burning within the unincorporated area of the County of El Dorado, adopted the following interim urgency ordinance, as provided for in Section 65858 of the Government Code, State of California, effective immediately for the preservation of public health, safety and welfare:


