The Board considered the approval of an official El Dorado County Flag which was selected by nine judges on July 15, 1976, from entries submitted by various El Dorado County youth groups who had designed and hand-made flags as a result of a contest initiated and coordinated by Boy Scouts of America Troop 140 in Coloma. The flag chosen for dedication at the County Fairgrounds on July 18, 1976, contains the grizzly bear and the American eagle facing each other, with a shield (gold pan) between them containing seven symbols of El Dorado County's heritage. Miss Kimberlee Knecht of the Gold Hill Toppers 4-H Club was the designer of this beautiful flag.

On motion of Supervisor Walker, seconded by Supervisor Stewart, and unanimously carried by those present, the Board approved and adopted the flag selected by the judges, as the official El Dorado County flag.
