The Board reconvened in regular meeting on June 16, 1978, at 9 a.m., with the following Board members present: Supervisors Todd, Johnson, Walker, Kutter and Stewart. Mary Anne Kinkade, Deputy Clerk, was present. Chairman Stewart presided.

On motion of Supervisor Johnson, seconded by Supervisor Kutter, and unanimously carried by those present, the Board authorized a 100% reduction of staff in the Mental Health Department as a result of organizational changes which eliminate that department from the County budget, approved deletions in the Authorized C.E.T.A. Personnel Resolution consistent with previous actions relative to regular employees, and added the Senior Nutrition Program to the exemption list for extra-help employees.

On motion of Supervisor Kutter, seconded by Supervisor Todd, and unanimously carried by those present, the Board directed that a boat presently being used by the Fish and Game Commission be declared surplus and transferred to the Purchasing Agent for further disposition.

On motion of Supervisor Stewart, seconded by Supervisor Johnson, and unanimously carried by those present, the Board authorized a 100% reduction of staff in the Mosquito Abatement District in County Service Area No. 3.

On motion of Supervisor Kutter, seconded by Supervisor Stewart, and unanimously carried by those present, the Board accepted and approved the recommendation of the Planning Director dated June 15, 1978, concerning deviation from seniority in the matter of layoffs.

On motion of Supervisor Stewart, seconded by Supervisor Walker, and unanimously carried by those present, the Board directed allowance for Extra Help in conjunction with the M.O.R.E. program, so that contractual obligations may be met.

On motion of Supervisor Johnson, seconded by Supervisor Todd, and unanimously carried by those present, the Board directed an amendment be made to a motion adopted at the June 13, 1978 Board meeting, concerning the reduction-in-force list of the Department of Agriculture; said amendment being the addition of the Deputy Agricultural Commission/Deputy Director of Weights and Measures, and the deletion of two Agricultural Biologist/Weights and Measures Inspectors III.
