"WHEREAS, in accordance with state law the Board of Supervisors now declare an emergency did exist throughout said county; and

"NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the State Director of the Office of Emergency Services with a request that he find it acceptable in accordance with provisions of the Natural Disaster Assistance Act; and

"IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that Vernon Peterson, Deputy Director of Emergency Services, is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the County of El Dorado for the purpose of receipt, processing, and coordination of all inquiries and requirements necessary to obtain available state assistance."

There being no further business, the Board adjourned.
