BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES January 11 19 84

The meeting of January 10, 1984, continued to this date, reconvened with all Board members present and Chairman Lowe presiding.

An Ordinance amending Sections 10.16.080 and 10.16.100 of the County Ordinance Code, to make hearings for abatement and removal of abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, or inoperative vehicles optional, was introduced, the reading thereof waived, and it was continued to January 17, 1984, for consideration of adoption, on motion of Supervisor Stewart, seconded by Supervisor Flynn, and unanimously carried.

Appointment of a District IV representative to the Commission on the Status of Women was continued to January 17, 1984, on motion of Supervisor Flynn, seconded by Supervisor Dorr, and unanimously carried.

Michael Owen was appointed as District IV representative on the County Fair Board of Directors, for a term expiring January 6, 1987, on motion of Supervisor Flynn, seconded by Supervisor Dorr, and unanimously carried.

Eunice White was appointed as District IV representative to the Library Commission, for a term expiring in January of 1987, on motion of Supervisor Flynn, seconded by Supervisor Walker, and unanimously carried.

The matter of K F R D Investments, Inc., advising it has removed much of the bank adjacent to Durock Road in Barnett Park to widen same and requesting the cost of said work, approximately \$9,000.00, be applied to road impact fees on future parcel map applications it will make in the Barnett Area Plan, was continued to February 14, 1984, on motion of Supervisor Flynn, seconded by Supervisor Stewart, and unanimously carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 3416 was adopted, on motion of Supervisor Walker, seconded by Supervisor Stewart, and unanimously carried, an Ordinance adding Chapter 5.54 to the County Ordinance Code establishing a system for the registration of commercial weighing and measuring instruments for the recovery of costs incurred from the inspecting and testing of same.

On motion of Supervisor Dorr, seconded by Supervisor Walker, and unanimously carried, a letter from Dewey L. Smart, dated January 8, 1984, complaining about the terrible condition of Latrobe Road, was referred to the Public Works Department.

On motion of Supervisor Walker, seconded by Supervisor Flynn, and unanimously carried, the Board agreed to notify S.A.C.T.O. (an organization that promotes industry in Sacramento, Yolo, and Placer Counties) that this County is interested in joining same, and to request written information from S.A.C.T.O. regarding matters such as membership fees, etc., for the Board's consideration during hearings on the 1984-85 County budget.

On motion of Supervisor Flynn, seconded by Supervisor Dorr, and unanimously carried, the Board directed that our State Legislators be reminded of the Board's support of ACA 35 (Bader), as previously stated on July 12, 1983, which would strengthen the SB 90 reimbursement process for local agencies, and request their assistance in getting ACA 35 through the Legislature.
