Chief John Williamson, Pleasant Valley Fire Protection District, was present and spoke on behalf of same, stating they do not feel recreation districts should be receiving funds that the fire protection districts need. Chief Williamson stated he fears that funds will be diverted from fire districts to recreation districts if the enabling legislation is enacted.

Chief Jerry Lewin, Shingle Springs Fire Protection District, was also present to speak to the needs of fire districts.

Mr. Howard Mosbacher was present and spoke on behalf of the needs of the Pleasant Valley Fire Protection District.

There were no further requests to speak, and the hearing was closed.

On motion of Supervisor Flynn, seconded by Supervisor Stewart, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the County Auditor-Controller's recommended allocation of Special District Augmentation Funds, totaling \$2,114,000.00, for fiscal year 1984-85, as outlined in his letter to the Board dated August 24, 1984.
