OVSC L BOARD ACTION - Board expressed its intent to certify the E.I.R. (n) and approve the Northwest El Dorado Hills Specific Plan and rezoning of properties within said Plan Area as requested, based on modifications heard this date; with formal approval to be considered on June 2, 1987, with staff given direction on wording to be brought back in the form of a formal motion on that date.

DVLSC Additionally, Board directed staff to draft an appropriate amendment to the County Long Range Plan to address the problem of traffic volume on Green Valley Road reaching level of service "F", which is 15,000 VPD (vehicles per day) for 30 days or more a year.
