Hearing to consider the Appeal filed by Oro Fino Gold Mining Corporation (Douglas A. Cloutier, Agent) on the Planning Commission's denial, without prejudice, of Special Use Permit No. 87-42, to allow a mineral exploration operation, using drilling methods described as diamond core, rotary and percussion, on property identified as APN's 91-010-20 and 39; 91-020-12, -16 and -32, consisting of 717 acres, currently zoned AE, Exclusive Agricultural, RA-40, Residential Agricultural Forty-Acre, and RE-10, Estate Residential Ten-Acre, located approximately one mile south of the intersection of Big Canyon and French Creek Roads, in the Shingle Springs, Latrobe, and Diamond Springs/El Dorado Areas. (Continued 3/16/88)

BOARD ACTION - Special Use Permit No. 87-42 denied on the following grounds: (1) A fair argument has been made by the opponents of the project that the project may have a significant impact on the environment, therefore, an E.I.R. should be prepared by the applicant to address the concerns that have been raised by the citizens in the area. Under the "no project alternative" in the E.I.R., it is proposed that there be an analysis on the need for the exploratory drilling operation in light of the core samples that have already been taken by Gold Fields Mining Company. In addition to the concerns raised by the citizens, the E.I.R. should contain an analysis of the land use conflicts between the proposed project and the existing and planned uses in the area. (2) Without a more comprehensive environmental analysis on the potential impacts of this project, the Board is unable to make the required finding under Section 17.22.050 of the County Ordinance Code that the issuance

of the permit will not be detrimental to the public health,

safety and welfare nor injurious to the neighborhood.
