This duty of the applicant to indemnify and save the County harmless includes the duties to defined set forth in California Civil Code Section 2778.

**THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED FOR
FULL ROAD CLOSURE PERMITS**

The application and required documents shall be submitted thirty (30) days prior to the event

- **ALL drawings must be submitted on a minimum 11" x 17" plan size**
 - **NO AERIAL GOOGLE MAP or GOOGE EARTH IMAGE DRAWINGS WILL BE ACCEPTED**
 - **NO FREE HAND DRAWINGS WILL BE ACCEPTED**
 - **ALL plans to be clearly legible and shall depict details that indicate all elements relative to this Road Closure**

- **Road Closure Plan:**
 - **All roads being closed shall be clearly identified, including all intersecting roads along the designated route**
 - **Clearly indicate the limits of the road closure**
 - **The minimum plan size shall be 11" x 17"**

- **Traffic Control / Signage Plan:**
 - **Signs shall conform to Traffic Operations Specifications per attached diagram**
 - **Clearly indicate the type and location of all proposed signs, barricades, cones, bio-degradable arrows / pavement markings and flagger placements**
 - **The minimum plan size shall be 11" x 17"**

- **Detour Plan:**
 - **Clearly delineate alternative routes or detours for affected neighboring residents and businesses to by-pass the road closure limits**
 - **The minimum plan size shall be 11" x 17"**

- **Certificate of Insurance:**
 - **Document must identify following: "County of El Dorado, its officers, officials, employees and volunteers included as additional insured, (ON A SEPARATE ADDITIONAL INSURED ENDORSEMENT) but only insofar as the operations under this agreement are concerned**
 - **This provision shall apply to the general liability policy in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00)**

- **The applicant shall be responsible for immediate and complete removal of all pavement markings, signs, and other road closure related materials following the closure.**
