Guest speakers Curtis Schmutte and Leo Winternitz to give presentations regarding the current Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta situation, The Nature Conservancy's role in the Delta and Peripheral Canal updates: a question and answer opportunity will follow the presentations. Leo Winternitz, M.S., former Deputy Director for the CALFED Bay-Delta Program, Executive Director of the Sacramento Water Forum and Assistant to Chief Deputy Director of the Department of Water Resources has over 30 years of water resource experience in California. Winternitz currently serves as the Director of Delta Projects for The Nature Conservancy.
