RE: Beginning of the 2024-2025 Influenza Season, Vaccination and Mask Recommendations

El Dorado County Health Officer announces that the beginning date for the annual healthcare worker influenza vaccination-and-masking recommendations for the 2024-2025 flu season will be *[effective October, 2024]*. For individuals who do not have a contraindication, seasonal influenza and COVID-19 vaccination is recommended. While vaccination is not a guarantee against contracting the illness, it will reduce the severity of the illness and can prevent the need for hospitalization or death.

As always, we recommend that healthcare institutions that see an uptick in cases not be precluded from implementing infection control precautions as appropriate, including vaccination and masking recommendations, requirements, or protocols. We encourage all healthcare staff to be cautious about potentially transmitting any illness, especially when working around people vulnerable to developing severe illness from any respiratory pathogen. Necessary precautions include staying home when experiencing symptoms of illness and voluntarily wearing medical masks around vulnerable people.

This decision is based on discussions with stakeholders and epidemiological data that show that influenza activity will potentially increase <u>state</u> and county-wide.
