June is Oral Health Awareness Month! It's time to acknowledge the power of healthy smiles and learn how we can keep our pearly whites shining bright.

Did you know that cavities can be prevented with a simple superhero called fluoride? Yes, you heard it right! Fluoride has the magical ability to reduce cavities by up to 33% in baby teeth. That's an impressive number, isn't it? But don't just take our word for it; find the article at the bottom.

Now, you may be wondering, "What exactly is fluoride?" Well, fluoride is a natural mineral that helps protect our teeth from the acid attacks caused by the bacteria in our mouths. It acts as a shield, strengthening the enamel (the protective outer layer of our teeth) and making it more resistant to decay.

Did you know that El Dorado County does not have fluoride in the drinking water? Here are some things you can do to still get fluoride for your teeth:

- Use fluorinated toothpaste.
- Drink brewed black tea.
- Eat canned shellfish.

Pro Tip: Did you know that dental care begins even before the arrival of those adorable baby teeth? Wipe your baby's gums twice a day with a soft, clean cloth—once in the morning after the first feeding and again before bed. This helps remove bacteria and sugars that can lead to cavities.

DR. April Westfall has been serving the community of South Lake Tahoe since 2010. Her passion is working with pediatric patients in underserved communities and volunteering her time to conduct in-class screenings in the Head Start programs on the Western Slope and in South Lake Tahoe. She also travels to rural areas of Alpine County to conduct screenings for students of all grade levels. Her dedication to improving the oral health of children without access to a dental home, allows students to get the care they need.

Some of the challenges Dr. Westfall is facing, is trying to meet the needs of all the patients in the community that need dental care, especially those on the Medi-Cal program. She is limited in capacity to serve as a single office, as well as limited in referral sources for specialized treatment in general, Dentists are facing higher costs in supplies, administration costs due to increasing regulation, while reimbursements from insurance companies and the Medi-Cal program do not increase in proportion to those rising cost of owning a dental clinic. Dr. Westfall's clinic in Placerville, will be losing one of her dentists due to retirement in June, but has already added Dr. Disha Kheni to her staff. She will be expanding some of the services offered, which will increase available resources for the Medi-Cal community.


