Subject: 2016 El Dorado County Wine Grape Survey

On the reverse of this page are the 2016 Wine Grape Survey results. All figures are actual values and acreage reported by growers. This survey, which goes out to over 250 growers, is a valuable resource for current and prospective vineyard owners and managers in El Dorado County.

Of special interest from the 2016 survey:

- The total value of grapes in El Dorado County was \$8,740,953 for 2016. This value is up 7.9% from the 2015 value of \$8,098,780.
- Average price per ton increased 3.9% from the 2015 price of \$1,502 per ton to \$1,561 per ton in 2016.
- Total production in 2016 was up 12.3% as compared to 2015 (6,026 tons in 2016 vs. 5,366 tons in 2015).
- Production in 2016 was averaged at 2.4 tons per acre, up 14.3% from the 2015 value of 2.1 tons per acre.
- Total wine grape tonnage sold outside of El Dorado County increased 1.7% from 2,498 tons in 2015 to 2,540 tons in 2016.
- Total bearing and non-bearing wine grape acreage for El Dorado County is 2,522 acres.
