

AGRICULTURAL GRADING APPLICATION CHECK LIST

*Every line of the two page application must be completed or have an "N/A".

EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLANS:

Site plan map must be submitted showing the following:	
	Existing roads,
	Existing buildings,
	Existing water bodies (ponds, streams, rivers, etc.),
	Topographic lines,
	Flow lines of surface water onto and off the site,
	Location of agricultural grading site,
	The perimeter boundary of the grading site and crop layout, including row spacing, row direction, and terraces, if any,
	Location and boundaries of all soil types,
	Required setbacks from any designated streams or waterways,
	Location of vegetation that will remain undisturbed by the grading,
	Location of all soil protection measures (mulching, cover crops, and other surface stabilization measures),
	Location of all storm water management and sediment control measures (drainage swales, berms, filter strips, silt fencing, sediment basins, channels, drop inlets, etc.)
A written description of the best management practices to be used must include the following:	
	Temporary and permanent best management practices,
	A schedule for implementation, maintenance, and upkeep of erosion and sediment control measures,
	Provisions for responsibility of maintenance, the date the plans were prepared, and the name of the person who prepared them.
