Summary

- Ag Department staff began analysis of Ag Districts in June 2009.
- On June 30, 2009, the BOS directed the Ag Department to continue the process of identifying parcels that should either be included or removed from the current Ag Districts (supporting Measure AF-J of the 2004 GP).
- Criteria used for parcel identification:
 - Proximity to existing Ag Districts,
 - General Plan land use designations,
 - Parcel size,
 - Soil type,
 - Slope
 - Elevation, and
 - Present land use
- Current acreage of all Ag Districts = 49,141 acres.
- Total acreage proposed to be added = 17,241 acres (originally was 30,607 acres).
- Total acreage proposed to be omitted from current Ag District acreage = 137 acres.
- 587 parcel owners were notified of the proposed addition or omission of their parcel into or out of an Ag District.
- All contested parcels were addressed during the May 2010 Ag Commission hearing.
