4. TIM (Traffic Impact Mitigation) FEE INCREASE- PRESENTED BY NATALIE PORTER

Natalie Porter handed out copies of the Board Agenda and Resolution for the Annual Update to Board of Supervisors from May 2019. She explained the history of RIF (Road Impact Fees) and TIM Fees, and the determination for specific charges within each zone.

Earl inquired how this affects the Affordable Housing Policy: existing houses vs. new dwellings and the impact of the mitigation fee on house prices.

Lori Burne asked about Age Restriction fees. In addition to age, certain criteria must be met to meet the standards set forth.

Jeff Short asked about major update, proposed calendar and staff reports being released earlier than board meetings. Posting of items mentioned is required 72 hours prior to meetings.

Earl McGuire asked how the current lawsuit would affect the TIM fee resolution. Natalie explained that that particular lawsuit is associated with the old TIM Fee resolution.

5. TRAKIT UPDATE

Tom Burnette gave an update on TRAKiT, testing will begin sometime in October for newer version.

6. PARTIAL UPDATE ON 2019 CODES

According to Tom Burnette, the Building Department just received "Significant changes to the Building and CA Codes". Tom handed out copies of the Table of Contents. There was discussion regarding solar requirements on second dwellings and homes with heavy tree coverage and Tiny House communities.

7. NV (Nevada) COUNTY GREENHOUSE PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS

Tom Burnette handed out a flyer from NV County on Greenhouse permitting. Tom explained that a customer brought this in for consideration in regards to growing Cannabis, to isolate plants from neighbors. Tom asked if anyone would like to be on a panel to discuss this.

8. LETTER OF APPRECIATION TO BUILDING DEPARTMENT

Jerry Homme asked everyone to review the letters that he and Earl McGuire wrote to the Board of Supervisors. Discussion ensued on making sure the letter is positive, any complaints should be in a separate letter along with the report to the Board of Supervisors later. It was agreed upon that Earl should write the Appreciation letter and to send it out to each member for review and editing. The letter will be part of the December 18, 2019 meeting for approval and signature.
