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Memorandum of Understanding

Between the

County of El Dorado and the [FIRE DISTRICT NAME HERE]

Regarding the

Delegation of Enforcement of Certain Fire and Panic Safety Provisions

Found in the 2019 California Building Standards Code

I. Purpose

California Health and Safety Code Section 13146 requires the responsibility for enforcement of building standards adopted by the State Fire Marshal related to fire and panic safety in R-3 dwellings, as described in Section 310.4 of Part 2 of the California Code of Regulations Title 24, to either the chief of the fire authority or the chief building official of the county. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to delegate those responsibilities where they pertain to R-3 dwellings located in the jurisdiction of both the County of El Dorado and the [FIRE DISTRICT NAME HERE], and also known collectively as "parties" to this agreement.

II. Scope

This MOU applies to the delegation of enforcement related to those fire and panic safety provisions for R-3 dwellings as found in California Code of Regulations Title 14, Division 1.5, Chapter 7, Subchapter 2 and Title 24, Parts 1 through 12.

III. Roles and Responsibilities

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between the parties as follows:

a. The COUNTY OF EL DORADO *Chief Building Official*, or their designee, shall be responsible for the enforcement of the following fire and panic safety provisions related to R-3 dwellings located in the jurisdiction of EDHFD

c. Both parties agree that when a new fire and panic safety provision related to R-3 dwellings is identified by either party, or the State Fire Marshal, during the term of this MOU that they shall as soon as practical meet and develop interim guidance for the enforcement of this provision until such time that an MOU amendment can be agreed on.

IV. Reporting Requirements

Parties agree to utilize the County of El Dorado's current permit tracking program to record the status of all related plan review/inspections performed as part of a R-3 dwelling construction project.

V. Duration

This MOU shall be in force upon the signature of authorized representatives from both parties, and shall sunset at the conclusion of the triennial code adoption process for the regulations identified in Section II.

VI. Limits

This MOU pertains to items associated with the enforcement of fire and panic safety provisions for R-3 dwellings as described in the California Building Standards Code only. This MOU does not pertain to all other occupancy types or subjects found in this code.

VII. Termination of MOU

Parties agree that the terms of this MOU may also be terminated with a written 30-day notice from either side. In the event of non-compliance or breach by one of the parties of the obligations binding upon it, the other party may terminate the agreement with immediate

effect. Parties also agree to meet and confer on issues of dispute in order to attempt to resolve potential non-compliance or breach issues prior to initiating provisions to terminate this MOU.

VIII. Approvals

The terms and conditions of this MOU are executed by the representatives whose signatures appear below on behalf of their respective agencies.
