FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT (FONSI)

FOR THE U.S. HIGHWAY 50/MISSOURI FLAT ROAD INTERCHANGE

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has determined that the U.S. Highway 50 /Missouri Flat Interchange Project will have no significant impact on the human environment. This FONSI is based on the attached Final Environmental Impact Report/FONSI and the previously approved Draft Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Assessment (EIR/EA), December 2003, which have been independently evaluated by the FHWA and determined to adequately accurately discuss the need, environmental issues, and impacts of the proposed project and appropriate mitigation measures. These two documents provide sufficient evidence and analysis for determining that an Environmental Impact Statement is not required.

The FHWA has cooperated with the County of El Dorado (the CEQA lead agency for the project) and with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and takes full responsibility for the accuracy, scope, and content of the attached EA and supporting technical studies.
