

PONDEROSA ROAD BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS FACT SHEET

Project Overview

The Ponderosa Road Class II Bicycle Route and Pedestrian Improvements from Foxwood Lane to Mineshaft Lane will construct approximately a half mile of Class II bike lanes and sidewalk. It will connect Ponderosa High School to Foxwood Lane, and include American with Disabilities Act and drainage improvements.

Status

The project received funding for planning, design, and right of way in March 2019, and a public workshop was held in July 2019. The project has received state and federal environmental clearance, and the design is approximately 60% complete. The project may be constructed in two phases. The first phase may include a concrete sidewalk and minor shoulder widening. The second phase of the project may include resurfacing Ponderosa Road and restriping to include the Class II bike lanes. The County is applying for competitive grant funds to complete the construction in the near future.

Purpose and Need

This project is included in the El Dorado County Bicycle Transportation Plan and will provide connection of active commercial and business areas, and increasing non-motorized access to jobs, services and schools.

Total Project Cost & Anticipated Completion

Total Cost: \$1,490,000

Anticipated Completion: October 2022

Funding

The project is currently being funding by Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program (CMAQ) funds, with Transportation seeking additional funding through various grant programs.
