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NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT
A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

NOTICE is hereby given that El Dorado County, within the State of California intends to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the project described below.

TITLE: Country Club Heights Erosion Control Project – Phase III (CCH-ECP)

LOCATION: The Project area is located in eastern El Dorado County, within the Lake Tahoe Basin, south of South Lake Tahoe. The Project is bounded by Highway 50/89 to the west, Elks Club Drive / Waverly Drive to the south, Boca Raton Drive to the east, and the Upper Truckee River to the west-northwest.

APN: County road right-of-way and APNs 033-191-004, 033-191-005, and 033-191-006

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: El Dorado County, Department of Transportation (County), is proposing to: install erosion control and water quality improvements to reduce the discharge of sediment and pollutants to Lake Tahoe from County administered rights-of-way and California Tahoe Conservancy owned property. The proposed improvements include but are not limited to a reconstructed reduced size parking lot, 2-unit restroom, shared use trail, infiltration basin, and pavement removal. The improvements will be constructed to reduce impacts to water quality at the northwestern end of the CCH-ECP boundary, enhance recreation and access opportunities, and provide for Stream Environment Zone (SEZ) habitat restoration.

REVIEW: The review period for the Mitigated Negative Declaration begins on January 16, 2020 and ends on February 14, 2020. The Mitigated Negative Declaration may be reviewed at the El Dorado County, Department of Transportation offices at 924B Emerald Bay Road, South Lake Tahoe, CA.
