RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND NOISE ELEMENT OF THE GENERAL PLAN TO INCORPORATE THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN INTO THE ELEMENT

WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado is mandated by the State of California to maintain an adequate and proper General Plan; and

WHEREAS, because of that mandate, El Dorado County's General Plan and the various elements thereof must be continually updated with current data, recommendations and policies; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 2140 provides that the State of California will not exceed 75 percent of total state elibible costs for disaster relief unless the County has adopted local hazard mitigation plan in accordance with the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 as part of the safety element of its General Plan adopted pursuant to California Government Code §65302(g); and

WHEREAS, the County has adopted its local hazard mitigation plan, entitled the El Dorado County Multi-Jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan on March 29, 2005; and

WHEREAS, an addendum to the 2004 General Plan Environmental Impact Report has been prepared with the appropriate findings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors adopts General Plan Amendment A08-0013, which consists of amendments to the Public Health, Safety, and Noise Element as shown in Exhibit A.

AMENDMENT TO OBJECTIVE 6.1.1 AND POLICY 6.1.1.1

Public Health, Safety, and Noise Element

GOAL 6.1: COORDINATION

A coordinated approach to hazard and disaster response planning.

OBJECTIVE 6.1.1: EL DORADO COUNTY OPERATIONAL AREA MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL LOCAL HAZARD EMERGENCY OPERATIONS FUNCTIONAL MITIGATION PLAN

The El Dorado County Operational Area Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Emergency Operations Functional Mitigation Plan shall serve as the implementation program for this Goal.

Policy 6.1.1.1 The El Dorado County Operational Area Multi-jurisdictional Local Hazard Emergency Operations Functional Mitigation Plan (LHMP) shall serve as the implementation program for the coordination of hazard planning and disaster response efforts within the County and is incorporated by reference to this Element. The County will ensure that the El Dorado County Operational Area Multi-Hazard Emergency Operations Functional Plan LHMP is updated on a regular basis to keep pace with the growing population.
