Conditional Use Permit Revision CUP-R21-0025/AT&T FirstNet Wireless Cell Tower Revision submitted by AT&T FIRSTNET C/O PEEK SITE-COM/FRANK SCHABARUM a request for a revision to an existing wireless communication facility with two (2) lattice towers of 35-feet height each. The revision would modify the North Tower to remove the existing AT&T antenna mounts, three (3) antennas, and associated equipment; and modify the South Tower by increasing the height from 35-feet to 45-feet and installing the three (3) antennas from the North Tower plus four (4) new antennas, for a total of seven (7) antennas located at the 41-foot centerline. The property, identified by Assessor's Parcel Number 119-090-021, consisting of 10.0 acres, is located on the east side of Morrison Road, approximately 0.2 mile east of the intersection with Hollow Oak Drive, in the El Dorado Hills area, Supervisorial District 1. (County Planner: Bianca Dinkler, 530-621-5875) (Categorical Exemption pursuant to Section 15303 of the CEQA Guidelines)*
