# **REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENTS – 2015 PROJECTS**

# **PROJECT 1**

### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

This project consists of improving **Green Valley Road from the County Line to Francisco Road.** Work includes completing a second eastbound lane from Sophia Pkwy to Francisco Road, a second westbound lane from Francisco Road to Brown's Ravine and Mormon Island to "The Purple Place" parking lot and signalizing the intersection of Green Valley Road at Brown's Ravine.

# **AREA OBSERVATIONS**

This road has heavy AM westbound commuter traffic. Entering the flow of traffic from the adjacent driveways is quite difficult. Earthwork will be extensive due to large cut slopes on the north side and will include retaining wall removal. Traffic control will be extensive as well because of this road being a major access route to El Dorado Hills and Folsom traffic. Right of Way cost is based from Exhibit G of Interim 2004 General Plan Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee (GPTIMF) Program Final Report.
