

# I AM OUT OF CUSTODY AND HAVE PRIOR FELONY CONVICTIONS.

## DOES PROP 47 APPLY TO ME?

On November 4, 2014, California voters passed Proposition 47, a law that reduces or lowers many theft and drug-related felonies to misdemeanors. Prop 47 applies to people: 1) with pending cases; 2) those currently serving a sentence; and 3) to those who have already completed their sentence (no matter how old the case is).

To be eligible for Prop 47 relief, you must:

1. Have been convicted of a qualifying Prop 47 felony (*see first box below*), **AND**
2. Not have certain prior convictions or be required to register as a sex offender (*see second box below*)

If you are **out of custody** and have a prior felony conviction that you believe may be eligible to be lowered to a misdemeanor under Prop 47 even if you are **under supervision** (Probation, Parole, PRCS, Mandatory Supervision), call us at (530) 621-6440 Monday through Friday.

CRIMES COVERED BY PROP 47:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Burglary of a store during business hours (\$950 or less) (PC 459)</li><li>• Forgery of check, bank note, or other financial instrument (\$950 or less) (PC § 473)</li><li>• Check fraud/bad checks (\$950 or less) (PC § 476a)</li><li>• Grand theft, including auto theft (if \$950 or less) (PC § 487; possibly VC 10851)</li><li>• Receiving stolen property (if \$950 or less) (PC §496)</li><li>• Grand/Petty theft with a prior (PC § 666)</li><li>• Possession of concentrated cannabis (HS § 11357(a))</li><li>• Possession of drugs, e.g., meth, PCP, mushrooms, etc. (HS § 11377)</li><li>• Possession of drugs, e.g., cocaine, heroin, Vicodin, etc. (HS § 11350)</li></ul>

YOU DO <u>NOT</u> QUALIFY FOR PROP 47 IF YOU HAVE ONE OF THESE PRIOR CONVICTIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Murder or Gross Vehicular Manslaughter (including attempted) (PC 187-191.5)</li><li>• All sex crimes requiring <b>mandatory sex offender registration under 290(c)</b>, including attempts/conspiracies (e.g., rape, molest, sodomy, sexual battery, indecent exposure, possession child porn, pimping &amp; pandering, etc.)</li><li>• Assault on police officer/firefighter with machine gun (PC 245(d)(3))</li><li>• Solicitation to commit murder (PC 653f/187)</li><li>• Possession of weapon of mass destruction (PC 11418(a)(1))</li><li>• Any serious or violent felony <b>punishable by life in prison or death.</b></li></ul>
