• Alternate Program

- 5221 Butte Creek Road- All cleanup activities and sampling have been completed. EMD is waiting on the Final Summary Report, based on email communications there seems to be a money issue between the contractor and subcontractor that are delaying this.
- 4991 Sciaroni Rd (USPS) USPS submitted another Final Summary report, missing waste removal documentation and arborist report. Contractor states parcel will be completed by April 3, 2023
- Both parcels have a deed restriction recorded on December 15, 2022 and will be removed once all final reports are submitted and approved.
 - Asbestos Assessments Complete: 20
 - Biological Assessments Complete: 15
