Please accept this memo as a weekly update to the activities surrounding the County of El Dorado's recovery from the Caldor Fire as managed by the Recovery Operations Center's (ROC) co-directors Sgt. Moke Auwae and me.

### Environmental Management

#### CALDOR FIRE

- **Alternate Program**

- 5221 Butte Creek Road- All cleanup activities and sampling have been completed. EMD is waiting on the Final Summary Report, based on email communications there seems to be a money issue between the contractor and subcontractor that are delaying this.
- 4991 Sciaroni Rd (USPS) – USPS submitted another Final Summary report, missing waste removal documentation and arborist report. Contractor states parcel will be completed by April 3, 2023
- Both parcels have a deed restriction recorded on December 15, 2022 and will be removed once all final reports are submitted and approved.
  - Asbestos Assessments Complete: 20
  - Biological Assessments Complete: 15
- ROE Universe:
  - 20 received and approved:
    - 11 per permitted structures
    - 9 or unpermitted dwellings/outbuildings
- Vehicles:
  - VIN verification was completed.

### Land Use

#### CALDOR FIRE

- **Fee Waivers** – 144 received
  - Temporary Mobile Homes/Temporary Recreational Vehicles
    - 90 Received

- 102 Approved (even if they didn't request a TRV/TMH but were eligible for a fee waiver, TRV/TMH permit fees are included in the approved waiver along with the requested permit fees to avoid the need for additional fee waiver requests/approval should the need the TRV/TMH permit)
- **Single Family Home Rebuild Permits** – 78 received
  - Replacement Home Permits – 64 received, 38 issued, 26 pending
  - Home Repair Permits – 10 received, 3 issued, 7 pending
  - Convert Mobile Home to Permanent Permits – 4 received, 3 issued, 1 pending
- **TRV Permits** – 52 Received
  - 40 Issued
  - 12 Pending
