Please accept this memo as a weekly update to the activities surrounding the County of El Dorado's recovery from the Caldor Fire as managed by the Recovery Operations Center's (ROC) co-directors Sgt. Moke Auwae and me.

### Environmental Management

#### CALDOR FIRE

- **Alternate Program**
  - 7255 Winding Way- all cleanup and sampling are complete. Waiting on Final Summary Report.
  - 5221 Butte Creek Road- All cleanup activities and sampling are complete. Waiting on the Final Summary Report, financial issues between the contractor and subcontractor are delaying the issuance.
- **USPS Grizzly Flats**
  - All cleanup completed; waiting on soil sample results.
- **USFS Parcels**
  - Complete
- **Public Program**
  - Complete

### Land Use

#### CALDOR FIRE


- **Fee Waivers** – 123 received
  - Temporary Mobile Homes/Temporary Recreational Vehicles
    - 70 Received
    - 86 Approved (even if parcel owners didn't request a TRV/TMH but were eligible for temporary power and demo permit, we included TRV/TMH in the initial approval in case of future need)
- **Rebuild Permits** – 53 received
  - 3 Building Permits Submitted & approved w/ Permit Fees Waived

- 33 Building Permits Issued w/out Permit Fees Waived
- 17 Building Permits Pending w/out Permit Fees Waived
- TRV Building Permits – 48 Received
  - 34 Issued
  - 14 Pending

### CALDOR FIRE


- **Long-Term Recovery**
  - Western Slope Foundation hosted an Out of the Ashes fundraiser on November 12, 2022 at Element 79 Vineyards.
- **Immediate Needs**

- **Social Worker**
  - On November 10, 2022, the Social Worker and Mental Health Worker were at Pioneer Park Community Center from 1:00pm – 3:00pm to provide support to Caldor survivors.
  - On November 10, 2022, the Social Worker met with the Salvation Army Disaster Case Manager.
- **Mental Health Worker**
  - The Mental Health Worker continues to provide support groups to the survivors (flyer below).
    - On November 5, 2022, six survivors participated in the Potluck Support Group.
  - They participated in the Grizzly Flat Western Slope Foundation Emotional and Spiritual Wellness Committee meeting.
    - The group will be putting a decorated Christmas tree where Walt Tyler Elementary school had been.
