Environmental Management

CALDOR FIRE

- **Alternate Program**

- 5221 Butte Creek Road- Soil Sample results submitted. Waiting on the final close-out paperwork from the contractor. *No changes from the previous report cycle*
- 4991 Sciaroni Rd (USPS) – USPS submitted another Final Summary report, missing waste removal documentation and arborist report. Contractor states parcel will be completed by April 3, 2023
- Both parcels have a deed restriction recorded on December 15, 2022 and will be removed once all final reports are submitted and approved.

MOSQUITO FIRE

- Tetra Tech Stats (as of March 2, 2023) **Debris Assessment & Removal is on hold due to weather*
 - Site Assessments Complete: 20
 - Asbestos Assessments Complete: 20
 - Biological Assessments Complete: 15
- Debris Removal Contractor – Anvil Construction. Anticipated start date is April 3, 2023 depending on weather and site conditions.

 - 102 Approved (even if they didn't request a TRV/TMH but were eligible for a fee waiver, TRV/TMH permit fees are included in the approved waiver along with the requested permit fees to avoid the need for additional fee waiver requests/approval should the need the TRV/TMH permit)
- **Single Family Home Rebuild Permits** – 77 received
 - Replacement Home Permits – 63 received, 38 issued, 25 pending
 - Home Repair Permits – 10 received, 3 issued, 7 pending
 - Convert Mobile Home to Permanent Permits – 4 received, 3 issued, 1 pending
- **TRV Permits** – 52 Received
 - 40 Issued
 - 12 Pending
