## • Alternate Program

- o 5221 Butte Creek Road- Soil Sample results submitted. Waiting on the final close-out paperwork from the contractor. *No changes from the previous report cycle*
- o 4991 Sciaroni Rd (USPS) USPS submitted another Final Summary report, missing waste removal documentation and arborist report. Contractor states parcel will be completed by April 3, 2023
- o Both parcels have a deed restriction recorded on December 15, 2022 and will be removed once all final reports are submitted and approved.
