EARLY CHILDHOOD COUNSELING PROGRAM

Every child deserves the best possible start in life. The extraordinary learning that takes place in the early years paves the way for success in school, in families and in relationships throughout life.



PARENT-CHILD INTERACTIVE THERAPY (PCIT)

PCIT works with parents and children between the ages of 2 and 7 years to improve the quality of the parent-child




relationship, and change problem behaviors. Parents receive live, in the moment coaching to improve their parenting skills

with special attention to handling difficult behavior which may have resulted in chronic problems at home, school or childcare.

SCHOOL-BASED MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAMS

When children suffer from emotional and behavioral problems at school, it is hard to focus on learning. Each school day is challenging for the children, their teachers, their parents and their peers.



New Morning's school-based mental health program provides support for children to improve their self-confidence and academic performance. Many New Morning therapists are located in elementary, middle and high schools throughout El Dorado County. Individual plans and goals are designed to meet the needs of each student, including individual and family counseling, support groups, classroom support and teacher consultation.

EMERGENCY YOUTH SHELTER

Many families struggle when their children reach adolescence. Some reach a breaking point and a young person is thrown out or runs away. When that happens, both the young person and the family need somewhere to turn, right away.

New Morning's Emergency Youth Shelter provides immediate shelter and drop-in services for youth in crisis, ages 6 - 17, seeking a safe place to stay.

We work with families and youth, helping them resolve conflicts and rediscover their common ground. We help young people understand the role they play in their family, school and community. New Morning's shelter program strengthens families and helps prevent youth homelessness.
