

Mosquito Fire Fee Waiver Process

El Dorado County Planning and Building Department

Many Planning and Building Department permit fees may be eligible to be waived to lessen the burden for Mosquito Fire Survivors during the rebuilding process. This document provides important information about the process to obtain fee waivers. Permit types that may be eligible for fee waivers include:

- Demolition
- Temporary Mobile Home/RV
- Model Water Efficiency Landscaping Ordinance (MWELO)
- Residential Building
- Non-Residential Building
- Grading

- Electrical (including temporary)
- Temporary Use
- Administrative

Initial Steps for Applicants:

- 1. Review Mosquito Fire Rebuild and Resiliency <u>Ordinance No. 5172</u> and Mosquito Fire Permit Fee Waiver Request Form for eligibility criteria.
- 2. Complete and submit the Mosquito Fire Permit Fee Waiver Request Form
 - a. Submit by email to mosquitofeewaiver@edcgov.us; or
 - b. Submit in-person at the Planning and Building Department

Additional Information for Applicants:

Applicant Has Insurance:

- All applicable permit fees waived, regardless of the extent of dwelling and/or structure coverage or who are determined to be underinsured
- Keep a copy of approved waiver(s) for future appointments

Applicant Does Not Have Insurance:

- All applicable permit fees waived
- Keep a copy of approved waiver(s) for future appointments

Complete Permit Application(s) and Schedule Appointment for Permit Application Submittal:

- Complete applicable permit applications
- For temporary RVs or Mobile Homes, complete the <u>Temporary RV/MH Permit Application Part 16(C)</u>
- For all other building permits, complete these permit applications:
