Medication Profile

Activated Charcoal

<u>Class:</u> (Charcoal Slurry)

Chemical Adsorbant

Action:

Inhibits gastrointestinal absorption of drugs or chemicals

Onset: Immediate Peak: Immediate Duration: 24 Hours

Adult Administration:

50 grams (250ml) PO

Pediatric Administration:

25 grams (125ml, hlf the contents of the bottle) unless a large quantity of intoxicant has been ingested, and where there is risk of life. In these circumstances, administer 50 grams (250ml).

<u>Indications</u>: <u>Contraindications</u>:

Suspected overdose, Accidental ingestion of drugs or chemicals Altered level of conciousness No gag reflex Ingestion of caustic, corrosives, or petroleum distillates

Side Effects:

RESP: Possible aspiration GI: Nausea, Vomiting

Pregnancy:

Notes:

• Milk products ingested prior to activated charcoal can reduce its effectiveness
