Medication Profile

Class: Anesthetic, Lubricant Lidocaine Jelly (Viscous Xylocaine)

Action:

Blocks the conduction of impulses and stabilizes neuronal membranes, thereby relieving pain. Lubricates mucus membranes to allow for insertion of gastric tubes.

Onset: 15-30 seconds

Peak: Unknown

Duration: 10-20min

Adult Administration:

Apply generous amount of jelly to NG tube or NPA before insertion.

Pediatric Administration:

Apply a generous amount of jelly to NG tube or NPA before insertion.
