## **Medication Profile**

Neosynephrine

(Phenylephrine)

Class:

Synthetic Sympathomimetic Agent

Action:

Produces long-acting vasoconstriction without chronotropic or inotropic actions on the heart.

Onset: Immediate Peak: 1-5 minutes Duration: 20-50 minutes

**Adult Administration:** 

1-2 spray(s) per effected nare

**Pediatric Administration:** 

1-2 spray(s) per effected nare

<u>Indications</u>: <u>Contraindications</u>:

Epistaxis Hypersensitivity/allergy Severe Hypertension

Ventricular tachycardia Closed-angle glaucoma

Side Effects:

Headache, Reflex Bradycardia, Excitability, Restlessness

Pregnancy:

Category C

Notes:

Adverse effects are minimal when Neosynephrine is applied topically
