- 2. The following are required for initial EMT Certification, Bring Copies:
 - Be at least (18) years of age or older
 - Current U.S. State-issued Driver's License or photo ID.
 - Current CPR certification Health Care Provider or equivalent level.
 - A Copy of one of the following:
 - A current National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician (NREMT) card.
 - A valid California AEMT or Paramedic card
 - A valid out of state EMT-Intermediate, AEMT, or Paramedic Card.
 - A copy of you EMT Course Completion Certificate from within 2 years (if available)
 - A completed Live Scan criminal background check by the state of California Department of Justice for El Dorado County EMS Agency (please ensure that our Live Scan form has been completed within 60 days.
