What is the need this grant supports?

This grant will support renovating the 1951 bathrooms to be up to date and ADA compliant. The repairs will include expanding the square footage in the hall to the second bathroom to accommodate wheel chairs, the floors will be leveled to make it easier to use self propelled wheelchairs, the toilet areas will be upgraded to include higher toilets and grab bars and will relocate the toilet paper and seat covers to be within reach. These upgrades are required to accommodate our veterans, many that are disabled and within our senior population.

The Community Center is a welcoming environment for veterans. To thank our Veterans, the Center offers free memberships to them for their service. We offer many events free pancake breakfasts, spaghetti dinners, bunko event, BBQ's, Arts and Craft events and other events throughout the year. There are also many volunteer opportunities for our veterans to participate in helping the Center build the Community spirit.

How will this grant address this need?

This grant will be an important part of our overall capital campaign to raise the monies needed to pay for the extensive bathroom renovations. It is estimated it will cost \$75000.

How are you suited to meet this need?

Our 100% volunteer community, is driven by meeting the needs of its community. We host many events, suggested by our community and utilize our volunteers from start to finish. We are uniquely qualified because of our ongoing outreach to get to know our community and to put together programs they want. Our goal is simply to provide a welcoming space for our community to get together and get to know each other while sharing a meal, or a laugh or by becoming a volunteer.

What is the grant timeline and what are the major milestones?

This work will be completed within 6 months. The major milestone will be to finalize 3 bids for the project. References will be checked. The Board will select a contractor with work to begin immediately. The President will be responsible for overseeing the project to ensure timelines and milestones are met.

What is the anticipated impact of the project?

This upgrade will have a significant impact. Folks have identified the bathrooms as the number ONE issue due to the difficulty of using the bathrooms. The bathrooms will be able to accommodate all of our guests including those with disabilities.

How will you measure the results of the project?

We expect an increase in membership of those with disabilities or seniors who previously were unwilling to come to our events or to use our facilities because of our challenging bathrooms. They will be more likely to come to our events and become more participatory in their community.
