Summary:

These are follow-up discussions to verify if it is prudent to add another higher demand estimate in the WRDMP chart to accommodate changed conditions after KJ study that was concluded in 2020. Yung-Hsin raised the question after his review of KJ study. Matt provided an email response on 8/28 with no objection to adding additional information in the WRDMP to better bracket the range of demands before additional refined studies can be conducted. TCPUD is expected to have further review of the KJ study. STPUD is engaging a master plan effort to reassess its projected demands, supply options, and facility plan. All agreed that is prudent to add another donut chart showing the estimate based on historical trends with more changed conditions.
