SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION INSTRUCTIONS

SURFACE AND WOOD PRODUCTS COATING OPERATIONS

- 1. In order to process your permit application and issue your permit, the Air Pollution Control District needs information about the materials and processes that are used in your wood products coating operations. The attached form is for your use.
- 2. The District needs to calculate the maximum amount of volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions generated by your coating process. <u>Your permit may state that you will be</u> <u>allowed to emit only that calculated amount</u>. For this reason, it will be to your advantage to list all coating materials that you expect to use. The attached form requests the information that the District needs to perform these calculations.
 - a. Description of the various coatings, stains, thinners, solvents, adhesives and other materials that you use.
 - b. VOC content of each material, <u>as it is applied after any thinning and/or mixing</u>.
 - c. Information about how you apply each of the materials.
 - d. Your estimates of the <u>maximum</u> amount, in gallons, of each material that you would expect to use daily, quarterly and annually.
- 3. If you are not sure of the VOC content of any material, your supplier may be able to furnish this information to you. VOC content is usually listed in pounds per gallon, as applied, or in grams per liter, as applied.
- 4. Follow the instructions in the notes at the bottom of the page of the form. If your usage of any item is in quarts or pints, so indicate.
